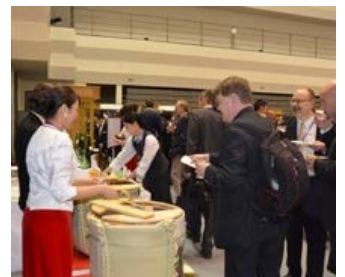
9 November	one afternoon tour
